Regular Rules and Regulations

- Entry must be postmarked no later than **May 26, 2023**. Any late entries are subject to approval based upon available time and space for the entry
- Entry fee must accompany entry
- **Entry fee is \$5.00 for open and \$4.00 for youth. Double cages are reserved for Standard birds only and are \$10.00/Double cage.**
- **Mail entries to: Sarah Kmetetz, 139 Kasson Road, Bethlehem CT 06751.**
- Any bird showing signs of sickness or disease will be removed from the show
- Early coop out is prohibited. Anyone cooping out before awards are presented will forfeit all prizes and may be subjected to refusal of future entries
- The club is not responsible for loss, accident or other damages you, your property or your entries
- Classes will be cock, hen, cockerel, pullet
- The poultry barn will be open at **7A.M.** on Sunday to receive entries; all entries must be cooped in no later than **9 A.M.** The barn will be open on Saturday from 3:00pm – 5:00pm to accept birds. If you arrive before 3:00pm, you will likely need to wait for our volunteers to finish setting up the show. If you arrive after 5:00pm, you will likely find a locked gate at the fairgrounds entrance.
- Initial shavings will be in cages, bring your own if you feel you will need more.
- All birds must have permanent Identification.

Poultry Health Requirements

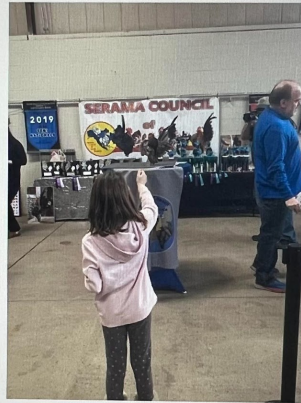
POULTRY: All poultry must be identified and test negative for **Salmonella pullorum** within 12 months of the show date and be accompanied by this certificate. Concurrent Avian Influenza testing of the flock and/or individual birds is strongly recommended. All poultry from outside of Connecticut must comply with the Department of Agriculture requirements by origination from AI-Free flocks or be tested within 30 days of entry and have a certificate. No poultry from any areas of any state having Avian Influenza may enter Connecticut. Poultry vaccinated within 30 days with any live virus vaccine will be prohibited from showing. All cages, crates and vehicles used for housing and transporting poultry must be cleaned and disinfected before and after each show. Doves, pigeons and waterfowl are exempt from testing requirements, but must be identified by leg bands or wing tags.

Purpose:

Rules:

- This is open to all youth, 18 years of age or younger.
- One application is required for each pair of birds.
- Though youth can submit multiple applications, each youth can only win up to one pair.
- Essays must be submitted **by Tuesday, May 30th** to gdanielcastle@gmail.com
- Winners will be chosen by the Connecticut Poultry Breeders Society Executive team at least one week before the annual CT Poultry Breeders Show.
- Winners must be present at the CT Poultry Breeders Show on Sunday, June 11th between the hours of 9:00am to 2:00pm.
- Because this is a youth award only, only the winning youth will be allowed to accept the award at the show. Substitutes are not permitted.
- Decisions will be based on Youth's expressed interest and knowledge in the breed they have chosen to apply for.
